



24 HOUR A YEAR KNIGHT

One of the many concerns expressed by our prospective members is that they may not have enough time to give to the Knights of Columbus. The following is reprinted from a recent article in the Supreme Program Supplement.

When talking to a prospective member about joining our Order, try breaking down the time commitment in this way:

- *Six hours a year on a council sponsored Church, community, council, family or youth project of his choosing*
- *Four hours a year attending two council meetings*
- *Four hours a year enjoying (with his family) a council social function such as a dinner, dance, picnic, etc.*
- *Four hours a year volunteering at the council's annual drive for people with intellectual disabilities, Knights of Columbus Free Throw Competition, K of C Soccer Challenge, the Substance Abuse Awareness Contest, or similar event.*
- *Four hours a year attending, with his family, two corporate Communion breakfasts or council prayer services at his parish.*
- *Two hours reading the council bulletin, council web site, state web site, Supreme Council Web site, and Columbia Magazine.*

That's only 24 hours a year that can help make a difference!
