This is the time of year you are requested to submit your Service Program Reports to the State Council reporting on your Council's service Program Activities for the CALENDAR YEAR 2011. This Handbook includes all the information you need including due dates, forms and directions. Look in Section B.3.4 of the Handbook for all the requested Forms and Due Dates. It is very important that your Council complete the requested reports. Know this about the reports; they don't have to be an award winning novel or a grade "A" term paper. All we request is that you complete the BASIC information on each report and mail it in. If there is a requested form for an activity and your Council did not participate in that event, just complete the basic information and write, "Did Not Participate" on the Form and you have completed your obligation.

By turning in the requested documentation, your Council is in the running to win awards at the Colorado KC State Convention. Some of you may think that is not important, but I would disagree. It is important to your Council members and the Parish & Community you support to see and outward sign that your Council is really helping and doing the work of Christ. In Matthew 5:16, Christ said, "Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven".

- Surge With Service Award (EVERY Council can win this award by completing the required forms)
- Service Activity Program Awards (Supreme & State)
- Father Francis Kappes Chaplain of the Year Award
- John J. Mildener Pro-Life Couple of the Year Award
- Knight of the Year
- Family of the Year
- Recruitment Award
- Retention Award
- Ceremonials Award
- Insurance Award
- Reactivation (Welcome Back Bother) Award
- Shining Knight Award

All reports must be received or postmarked NO LATER THAN February 1st to be eligible for credit toward the Surge With Service Award in order to earn points toward the Division Awards. **There is no need to overnight any reports.**

I want to summarize the important actions required for reporting for the Service Program Awards to ensure all of the councils in the state are eligible to win awards at the state conventions

Remember that all reporting of council activities is for the CALENDAR YEAR 2011

All reports requested are **due to the State Service Program Coordinator, John Eiler**. Do not send the reports to the District Deputy or State Deputy.

The reports are **due no later than February 1st**. This deadline is a Postmark Deadline. Please do not spend the money to overnight any reports.

Return ALL reports. If your council has not participated in an activity noted on a report, please annotate the report form as "Did Not Participate", and turn it in.

Ensure your Grand Knight has signed all report forms

All the information about the Service Activity Program is located in the **Service Activity Program Handbook**. This handbook can be found on the State Council Website under the "Program" Tab.

I want to remind you about the NEW SURGE WITH SERVICE Award. **Every Council in the State can earn this award** by completing the following report forms:

Submit forms SP-7, 185, 365, 1728 to the State Service Program Coordinator

Submit ALL SIX Service Program reports to the State Service Program Coordinator

Submit THREE or more Membership reports, (one must be the Recruitment report) to the State Membership Program Coordinator

District Deputies; please ensure your councils know about this new award.
